



MEMBERSHIP

PRIVILEGES

1. Receipt of all papers relating to the Society's Annual General Meeting (AGM). Each full Member Society is able to nominate three of their members to represent their Society at the RASC AGM. The member society will be entitled to one vote at the AGM.
2. The right for Member Society's members to attend to the biennial Conference at a discounted rate.
3. The right of Chief Executives of Agricultural Societies to take part in the Chief Executive's Seminar coinciding with biennial Conferences.
4. Access to the society's secretariat at any time.
5. Receipt of two copies of the Conference Report and six of the Society's quarterly Newsletter, Annual Report and other publications and papers.

OBLIGATIONS

1. The wide dissemination of all relevant papers and reports of this Society to the Member Society's Council, Officers and leading members.
2. Publicising the work of the RASC both in the Member Society, to other leading Agricultural Societies in the state/province, to Ministries and related NGOs and to educational and research establishments.
3. The payment of the annual subscription resolved on by the Board of Trustees.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

These are decided upon annually for the calendar year by the Board of Trustees. As with subscriptions to the Commonwealth itself and other international organisations, these depend upon the circumstances of the Member Society/Organisation.
